

Oakcliff Sailing Center Rules and Regulations

LIFEJACKETS:

Anyone under the age of 18 who is operating a motor vessel in the state of NY must have a boaters safety certificate on their person to operate the vessel. OSC prefers that persons under 18 do not operate motor vessels.

State of NY mandates that all person on the water between November 1st and May 1st must wear a PFD.

Furthermore, OSC requires that all sailors wear lifejackets when the water is below 55degrees or when the winds are over 15 knots. OSC prefers that all wear lifejackets at all times.

ALCOHOL etc.

There is no smoking or alcohol allowed aboard any Oakcliff Boats.

CONDUCT:

Whenever you are representing the Oakcliff Sailing Center it is expected that you will behave in a professional manner that will reflect positively on the Oakcliff Sailing Center. Any time you are wearing Oakcliff Sailing Center Team or Organization branded gear, at a sponsored event, at a sailing event as part of the Oakcliff Sailing Team or at the Oakcliff Sailing Center or on their boats you are representing the Oakcliff Sailing Center. The community at large and specifically the sailing community, sponsors and suppliers, and other employees and volunteers are to be treated with respect and there is to be no harassment or discrimination. No underage drinking or promoting of underage drinking or illegal drug use is permitted while you are on Oakcliff Sailing Center property or representing the Oakcliff Sailing Center.
